- 32 The golden calf – the tablets broken

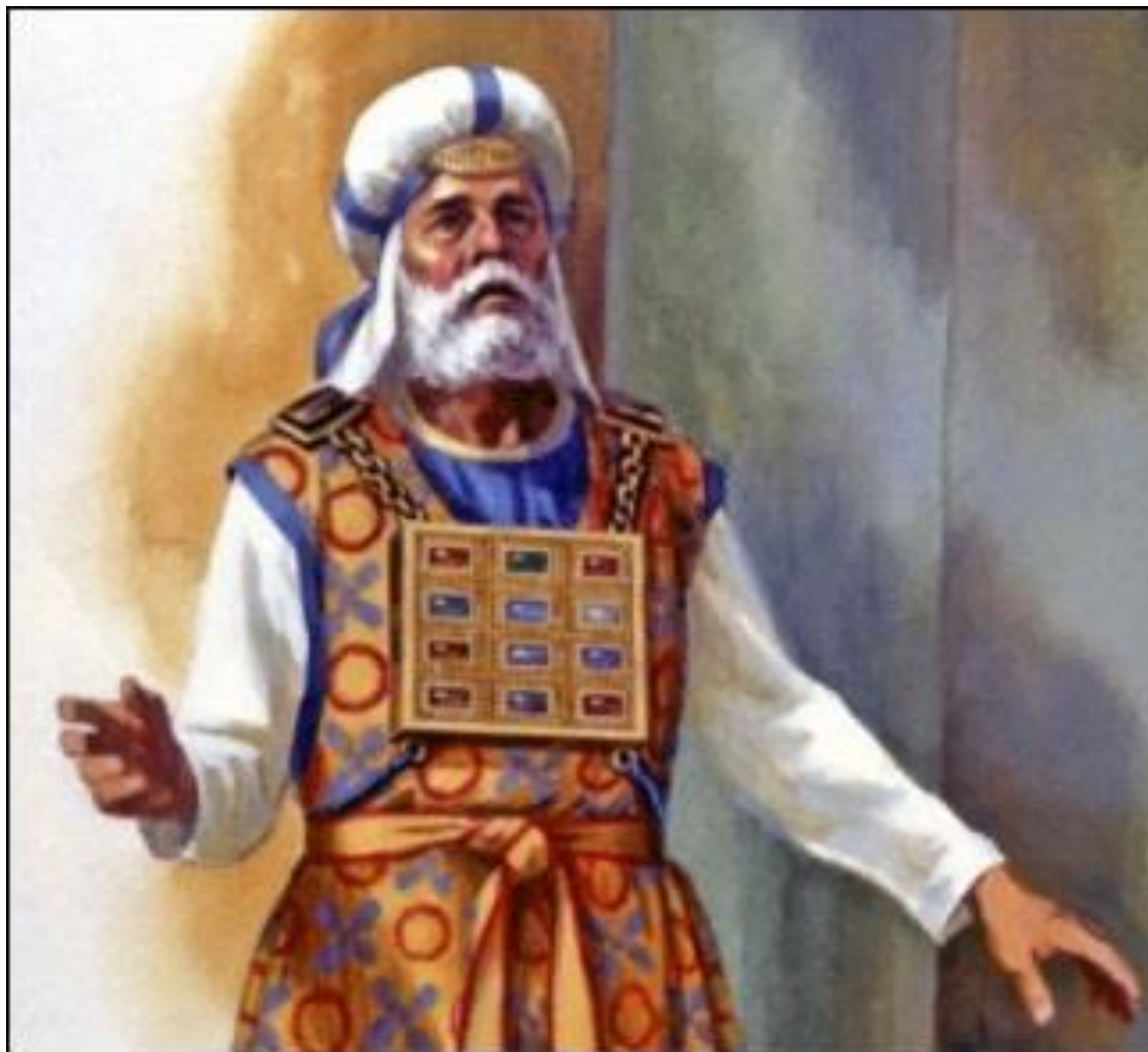

The people present Offerings for the tabernacle
- 36 Making the tabernacle, the ark of testimony, the table of shewbread, the gold lampstand,
the altar of incense, the anointing oil and incense, the altar of burnt offering,
the bronze laver, the court of the tabernacle, the garments of the priesthood,
the ephod, the breastplate
- 40 The tabernacle is erected and finished
